Please read all information carefully before signing the agreement below.

- 1. School owned instruments are issued on the basis of need, potential talent, and interest of the student. Students are chosen at the discretion of the music director.
- 2. Students renting an instrument will assume full responsibility for the care and maintenance of that instrument and will be responsible for the cost of repairs for said instrument should damage occur.
- 3. The student and his/her parents or guardians will assume the replacement cost of a lost or stolen instrument. The value of the instrument is determined by replacement cost of an identical brand and model or comparable model if original model is no longer manufactured.
- 4. It is possible homeowners insurance will cover loss or damage to an instrument.
- 5. A student will lose his/her privilege to use an instrument as well as forfeit the rental fee if it is found at any time that:
 - a. The instrument is being mistreated.
 - b. The student is not showing significant progress.
 - c. The student excessively misses or fails to bring the instrument to rehearsals.
 - d. The student, for any reason, drops the class.
- 6. The student will need to furnish his/her own rosin, cleaning cloth, shoulder rest (violins/violas), and rock stop (cellos). The student is responsible to return, in good condition, any materials supplied with the instrument.
- 7. In some cases, students may have to share an instrument.

Please sign this agreement and keep a copy for yourself. Return this form to the school as soon as possible. Fees will be collected through your Infinite Campus account.
